

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NOTE: The unit works vertically only. Do not play it horizontally. It could damage the vinyl discs. It can be placed or hung on the wall.

BeforeUsing the Unit

- As the unit may become warm during operation, always leave sufficient space around the unit for ventilation.
- The voltage supplied to the unit should match the voltage as printed on the rear panel. If you are in any doubt regarding this mattert consult an electrician.
- Choose the installation location of your unit carefully. Avoid placing it in direct sunlight or close to a source of heat. Also avoid locations subjed to vibrations and excessive dust, heat, cold or moisture.
- Do not place the unit on an amplifier/receiver.
- Do not open the cabinet as this might result in damage to the circuitry or eledrical shock. If a foreign objed should get into the unit, contact your dealer or se~ice company.
- When removing the power plug from the wall outlet, always pull directly on the plug, never yank the cord.
- To keep the laser pickup clean, do not touch it and always close the disc tray.
- Do not attempt to clean the unit with chemical solvents as this might damage the finish. Use a clean, dry cloth.
- Keep this manual in a safe place for future reference.

DO NOT MOVE THE UNIT DURING PLAYBACK

During playback, the disc rotates at high speed. Do NOT lift or move the unit during playback. Doing so may damage the disc or the unit.

WHEN MOVING THIS UNIT

When changing the unit's location or packing the unit for moving, be sure to remove the record or disc. Moving this unit with the record or disc loaded may result in damage to this unit. If the unit is to be packed and moved a great distance, it is also advisable to tighten the turntable transport locking screw. See Page 9 for instructions.

Discs

Discs which can be played on this unit:

 Conventional audio CDs bearing the CD-DA logo on the label:



- Properly finalized CD-R and CD-RW discs
- Always place the disc on the disc tray with the label side up.
- To remove a disc from its storage case, press down on the center of the case and lift the disc out, holding it carefully by the edges.







How to hold the disc


 Should the disc become dirty. wipe the surface radially (from the center hole outward towards the outer edge) with a soft, dry cloth:



- Never use such chemicals as record sprays, antistatic sprays or fluid. benzine or thinner to clean the discs. Such chemicals will do irreparable damage to the disc's plastic surface.
- Discs should be returned to their c:ases after use to avoid dust and scratches that could cause the laser pickup to "skip."
- Do not expose discs to direct sunlight or high humidity and temperature for extended periods. Long exposure to high temperatures will warp the disc.
- Do not play any disc that is warped, deformed or damaged.
 Playing such discs may cause irreparable harm to the playing mechanisms.
- CD-R and CD-RW discs are more sensitive to the effects of heat and ultraviolet rays than ordinary CDs. It is important that they are not stored in a location where direct sunlight will fall on themi and away from sources of heat such as radiators or heat-generating eledrical devices.
- Do not stick papers or protective sheets on the discs and do not use any protedive coating spray.

Handing Records

 Do not touch the record's grooves. Only handle records, by the edges or the label. Make sure your hands are clean. Skin oils from even clean hands can leave a residue on the record surface that will gradually deteriorate the quality of your record.



- Keep your racords away from dust. Keep them in a cool, dry place.
- To avoid dust and scratches, keep records in their sleeves and jackets when not in use.
- Do not expose records to direct sunlight or high humidity and temperature. Long exposure to high temperatures will warp the record.
- Should the record become dirty, gently wipe the surface in a circular motion, using a soft anti-static cloth.



How to Replace the Stylus

The stylus should last after many hours under normal use. However, it is recommended that the stylus be replaced as soon as you notice a change in sound quality.

Prolonged use of a worn-out stylus may damage the record.


Wear and tear on the stylus will be accelerated when playing 78 RPM records. The higher speed of 78 RPM records can wear the stylus more quickly.

Caution;:

- Do not remove or bend the stylus.
- To avoid injury, do not touch the needle.
- Turn off the unit's power before you replace the stylus.
- Keep out of the reach of children.
- Handle with care, as the stylus is delicate. Use of a bent or
- broken stylus may damage the record and cause the turntable to malfunction.
- Do not expose Stylus to extreme heat.


Removing an old stylus

- 1.Set a screwdriver at the tip of the stylus and push down to the direction "A".
- 2. Pull the stylus out toward direcOon "B".





Installing a new stylus

- 1.Hold the tip of the stylus and insert the other edge by pressing toward direction "C"
- 2. Push the stylus up toward direction "D" until it locks at the tip.



Parts of the Turntable




Before use, detach the stylus guard (white plastic cover) by pulling it straight off the front of the cartridge in the direction of the arrow.

- **D** speed selector







Never place more than one disc on the tray.

If you play CD Several seconds later the total number of tracks and total playing time will appear on the display.


If you play MP3 disc, several seconds later the total number of folders and total Number of tracks will appear on the display.

6 Press the PLAY/PAUSE button play to start playback.



7 Turn the VOLUME knob to adjust the volume.





A To suspend playback temporarily (pause mode) PLAY/PAUSE



Press the PLAY/PAUSE button during playback. playback stops at the current position, and the track number blinks in the display.

To resume play back, press the PLAY/PAUSE button again.

B To stop playback



Press the STOP button to stop playback.

□ To skip to the next or a previous track

MUSIC SKIP



During playback. repeatedly press the SKIP button (skip- or skip+) until the desired track is found. The selected track will be played from the beginning.

In the stop mode, press the SKIP-/SKIP+ button (skip- or skip+) repeatedly until the track you want to listen to is found. Press the PLAY/PAUSE button within 5seconds to start playback from the selected track.

 When the skip- button is pressed during playback, the track being played will restart from the beginning. To return to the beginning of the previous track, press the skip+ button twice.



During playback. hold down the MUSIC SKIP button (skip- or skip+) and release it when the part you want to listen to is found.

D Search for a folder of a disc

If you play a usb/sd/disc with folders press this to Choose the folder you want



E REPEAT Function If the USB/SD/disc has no folder

Press "REPEAT" button once to repeat one single track.

Press "REPEAT" button one more time to repeat all tracks.

Press "REPEAT" button three times to cancel the random function.

If the disc/USB/SD has folder

Press "REPEAT" button once to repeat one single track.

Press "REPEAT" button one more time to repeat the currently.

playing folder

Press "REPEAT" button three times to repeat all tracks of the disc.

Press "REPEAT" button four times to cancel the random function.

Program Function

In stop mode,

If the USB/SD/Disc has no folders, press the PROGRAM button, the display will show "MEMORY" and blinking "P01". Press the skip- or skip+ button to select your ideal track and press the PROGRAM button again to save the track.

If you want to save another track, repeat the above steps

This unit can program up to 20 tracks

To playback the programmed track, press the PLAY/PAUSE button. Press the STOP button one time to stop the playback. Press the STOP button one more time to erase the programmed track, and the "MEMORY" will disappear on the display. If turn off the power of the unit, or set the function knob to other modes (USB-SD/AUX-PH/TUNER/TAPE). the programmed tracks will be automatically erased.

If the USB/SD/Disc has folders,

press the PROGRAM button, the display will show "MEMORY" and blinking "P01". Press the SKIP- or SKIP+ button to select your ideal folder and press the PROGRAM button again to save the folder. Then "P01" will blink again. Press the SKIP- or SKIP+ button to select your ideal track and press the PROGRAM button once more to save the track. You can repeat the above steps to select all your ideal tracks.

This unit can program up to 20 tracks.

To playback the programmed track, press the PLAY/PAUSE button. Press the STOP button one time to stop the playback. Press the STOP button one more time to erase the programmed track. and the "MEMORY" will disappear on the display.

If turn off the power of the unit or set the function knob to other modes (USB-SD/AUX-PH/TUNER/TAPE). the programmed tracks will be automatically erased.






PLAYING AUX-IN

Press the power button to turn the unit "on" Set the function knob (CD/USB-SD/AUX-PH/TUNER/TAPE) to the AU in position. Connect AUX-IN cord into the AUX-in jack to play the external source, such as CD player, cassette tape deck, "MP3" etc...






Put the record on the turntable.45RPM adaptor is built in the top turntable fixer (A).



For the 45RPM, center carefully with the help of the 3 small teeth on the blade fixing centering.

6 Unlock the tone arm off the tone arm support.




Move the tone arm gently to the edge of the record (or the starting point of a track).

The turntable will begin to turn. Please make sure the stylus is well fixed.



8 Gently lower the tone arm.




9 Turn the VOLUME knob to adjust the volume.





• Playing records with the dust cover down will prevent dust from settling on the turntable.

Listening to the Radio





1 PUSH the power button to turn the unit 'on'



2 Set the function knob (CD/ USB-SD/ AUX-PH/TUNER) to the Tuner.



3 Select AM or FM using this button.



- 4 Select FM. the LED light of FM will 'on"If the signal is strong.
- 5 Turn the tuning knob to tune in a station.

5 Turn the VOLUME knob to adjust the volume.



If the reception is poor




Turn around the unit to find the best position for AM stations.

Listening to a USB disk or SD card





USB and **SD** playing

1 PUSH the power button to 'on'.



2 Set the function knob (CD /USB-SD /AUX-PH / TUNER) to the USB / SD.



Insert USB disk or SD card into slot. --- --- After I second.the LCD will display the total folder and tracks.

If no USB disk or SD card. 'NO' will show on the display.

Press ' PLAY / PAUSE' to start music playback. Turn the volume knob to adjust to volume.






- 5 Press the SKIP-/SKIP+ once or repeatedly until the desired track number appears on the display.Playback will begin automatically.
- 6 You can press V/A USB/ SD/ MP3 DISC FOLDER button to choose the desired folder.
- 7 Press STOP to stop playback

To pause the music. press PLAY/ PAUSE. press it again to resume play. If USB disk and SD Card both in the port, please long press 'PLAY/ PAUSE' button to choose the playing of USB disk or SD Card.




Recording AUX Record/ Radio to USB/SD

1 PUSH the POWER button to turn the unit on.




- 2 Insert USB device or SD card to the disk.
- Set the function knob (CD / USB-SD/AUX-PH/TUNER) to the AUX-PH/TUNER in position.



- 4 Start playback of the record/radio at the point you want to start recording.
- 5 Press the RECORD/ERASE button one time to start recording .and ONE will blink on the display , press SKIP-/SKIP+ button choose the ONE/ALL (Single/ALL play) Again Press the RECORD/ERASE button one time to choose the USB/SD.

Press the RECORD/ERASE button one more time to confirm, and the recording process starts.

6 Press the STOP button to stop the recording process. and "END REC" will appear on the display.



Recording CD/MP3/WMA to USB/SD

1 1) PUSH the POWER button to turn the unit on.




- 2 Insert USB device or SD card to the unit.




- 4 Start playback of the CD/MP3/WMA at the point you want to start recording.

USB and SD RECORDING





Recording USB to SD or SD to USB

11 PUSH the POWER button to turn the unit on.



- 2 Insert USB device and SD card to the unit.
- Set the function knob (CD/USB SD/AUX-PH/ TUNER) to the USB/SD in position.



- 4 Start playback of the USB/SD at the point you want to start recording.
- 5 Press the RECORD/ERASE button to start recording.

If the USB/SD has no folder, press the SKIP-/SKIP+ button to select the content you want to record (the currently playing track or all tracks)

If the USB/SD has folder, press the SKIP-/SKIP+ button to select the content you want to record (the currently playing track, or tracks in the currently selected folder or all tracks)

6 Press the STOP button to stop the recording process, and "END REC" will be shown on the display.

Deleting MP3/WMA tracks on the USB disk or SD card

1 PUSH the POWER button to turn the unit on.



- 2 Insert USB device or SD card to the unit.
- 3 Set the function knob (CD/USB-SD/AUX-PH/TUNER) to the USB/SD in position.



- 4 Select the track you would like to delete, and begin the playback.
- 5 Press and hold the "RECOAD/ERASE" button for approximately two seconds, and "DEL ONE" will blink on the display.
- To erase the whole folder or all the files, select "FOLD" or "ALL", using SKIP+/- buttons and confirm with REC/ERASE button. To cancel the operation, press "STOP" button.

Troubleshooting

If you experience any problems with the unit, please take a moment to look through this chart and see if you can solve the problem yourself before you call your dealer.

No power

→ Check the connection to the AC power source. Check and make sure the AC source is not a switched outlet and if it is, the switch is turned on. Make sure there is power to the AC outlet by plugging another item such as a lamp or fan.

No sound.

Adjust the volume,

The sound is noisy.

→ The unit is too close to a TV set or similar appliances. Relocate the unit further away from them, or turn the other appliances off.

Tuner

Cannot listen to any station. or signal is too weak.

- ➤ Tune in the station properly.
- → If a TV is near the unit, turn it off.
- → Rotate the unit or antenna wire for the best reception position.

Record Player

Will not play.

- → Turn the VOLUME knob clockwise, and turn the function to AUX/PH mode
- ➤ Loosen the screw, and detach the stylus guard. (The stylus guard is a white plastic cover that protects the stylus during transportation. Failing to remove this guard will not allow the needle to contact the grooves of the record and no sound will be heardl)
- → If the stylus is worn-out, change the stylus.
- Select the correct playback speed.

Sound skips.

- Place the unit on a stable surface to avoid vibration and shock. Make sure the unit is level both front to back and side to side.
- → Clean the surface of the record/disc.
- → Don't use scratched, damaged or warped records/discs.

CD Player Will not play.

- Turn the VOLUME knob clockwise, and turn the function to CD mode
- ➤ Load a disc with the playback side facing down.
- → If the disc is dirty, clean the surface of the disc.
- → A blank disc has been loaded. Load a prerecorded disc.
- → Depending on the disc, etc. it may not be possible to play back CD-R/CD-RW discs, Try again with another disc,
- → You cannot play back unfinalized CD-R/CD-RW discs. Finalize such a disc in a CD recorder and try again.

USB/SD Player Will not play

- → Some USB flash drives and SD cards may not be compatible with this unit.
- → Pls check the specification on the last page of this manual .

If normal operation cannot be obtained, unplug the power cord from the outlet and plug it again.

Beware of condensation

When the unit (or a record/disc) is moved from a cold to a warm place. or used after a sudden temperature change, there is the danger of condensation; vapor in the air could condense on the internal mechanism, making correct operation erratic or impossible. To prevent this, or if this occurs, leave the unit turned on for one or two hours.

Maintenance

Always keep the turntable clean.

If the surface of the unit gets dirty, wipe with a soft cloth or use a diluted mild liquid soap. Be sure to remove any excess liquid completely. Do not use thinner, benzine or alcohol as they may damage the surface of the unit. Allow the surface of the unit to dry completely before using.
